





ST IVES SCHOOL GUIDANCE ON SOCIAL DISTANCING

Welcome to St Ives School:

St Ives School is asking for the support and understanding of our visitors in helping us minimise the risk of COVID-19.

St Ives School continues to follow guidance from Public Health England and therefore, we are now limiting access to the site to essential visitors only and by appointment only.

If your visit to St Ives School is an essential one, we would nevertheless ask that you refrain from visiting if:

- you have any symptoms of COVID-19 such as: a fever, a new continuous, dry cough or loss or change to your sense of smell or taste
- you, or anyone in your household is required to self-isolate in accordance with Government guidelines.

Along with all members of the St Ives community, any visitors to the School should wash their hands before leaving home, and sanitise their hands before entering the school buildings. Visitors should also use sanitiser and/or wash hands at regular intervals throughout the day.

The School is also operating as a COVID secure workplace and visitors must abide by strict social distancing protocols whilst on site. This includes staying a minimum of 2 metres from others and following the instructions of staff and signage where appropriate.

We would also like to advise you that the School is currently operating a 'no handshake' policy for all members of its community.

All visitors to the site are now required to wear an appropriate face covering for the duration of their visit.
