The Ivies is a **fun**, **stimulating** and **vibrant** setting where children often experience their first taste of school. Our team is highly trained, experienced and provides a **warm**, **caring** environment where children learn to be **independent**, **confident**, **sociable** and develop a positive approach to learning.

Days are carefully planned to develop children's social, physical and **intellectual growth** whilst maintaining a real sense of fun and **enjoyment**. Our nursery boasts a modern, purpose built building with large, **bright and airy** classrooms. The children enjoy full access to an **outdoor play** and woodland area.

We welcome both girls and boys from the age of two years.

PRE-PREP (RECEPTION-YEAR 2)

St Ives' Pre-prep department – 'The Ivies' – has a wonderfully **warm** and **nurturing** atmosphere. This, combined with the **buzz** and **enthusiasm** of staff and children alike, make The Ivies a very **happy** place to be. With stunning views across miles of countryside, the **bright**, colourful classrooms are a fantastic environment for learning and play.

Teaching standards are very high, with experienced, dedicated teachers and assistants committed to doing their very best for the children in their care. This is evident in the **fantastic results** and **progress** that our children achieve. Core subjects are taught by class teachers, and topics are tailored to the childrens' interests. Right from the start of their education at St lves, children have **specialist teachers** for **Music**, **PE**, **French** and **Spanish**. **Small class** sizes allow teachers to really get to know each child, and to tailor and differentiate learning according to their **individual needs**. Our pupils' **happiness** is extremely important to us, and **pastoral care** is a priority. Personal, Social and Religious Education are taught weekly; dedicated weekly Pre-prep assemblies foster a sense of community; and a Worry Box is available for any children needing a listening ear and pastoral support.

Outstanding grounds and play areas provide an exhilarating outdoor space for play; while the acres of forest on our grounds enable every child to take part in Forest School every week.

PREP (YEARS 3-6)



Years 3-4

The next stage in the St Ives journey marks the transition into Prep school. This often represents a new level of **independence**, **self-reliance** and **organisation** as the children move around the building for specialist lessons. Maths, English and Science remain at the core of the curriculum but there is generous provision for areas such as Music, Art, Computing, French, Spanish, PE and Drama.

Years 5 & 6

While our focus continues to be on a very rounded provision, children are guided in **exam technique** to help them **achieve entry to their first choice of senior school**. We are not only proud of our **entry success** but also the **positive feedback** we receive about our pupils' preparation for senior school. We regularly send children with scholarship awards to schools such as Guildford High School, St Catherine's School, Cranleigh School, Churcher's College, Tormead, Seaford College, Prior's Field and Frensham Heights.

We also provide a strong post-examination programme for Year 6 which incorporates life skills, community work, business enterprise, team building, and local charity work.

SPORTS & THE ARTS



Sports

Participation in sports is embraced at St Ives as we believe that it is not only good for **health** and general **well-being**, but also helps to develop an appreciation of **team spirit**, **fair play** and builds self-confidence. Over the years St Ives has developed a **strong reputation** for **competitive sports** amongst our peers and we pride ourselves on the **sporting achievements** of the children. We encourage everyone to take part in matches and make every effort to provide opportunities for them to represent the school.

We are fortunate enough to have three full size **tennis and netball courts**, **athletics track**, mini **hockey pitch** and large **gymnastics hall**.

Our pupils have the opportunity to take part in a variety of sports from **netball**, **hockey** and **rounders** through to **cross country**, **swimming**, **badminton**, **golf** and **cricket**.

Music & Drama

We believe that involvement in the performing arts can help children to **express themselves** and build their **confidence**. Two **choirs**, an **orchestra**, **ensembles** and individual **instrumental and singing lessons** greatly enrich the curriculum. We have a large team of peripatetic teachers offering tuition in a wide range of musical instruments. **Dance** and **Speech & Drama** run throughout the year alongside our **Production Club** in preparation for our annual summer production.

Art & Design

Stimulating the childrens' creativity and imagination is another key way to develop **self-expression**. Pupils are able to experiment with a wide variety of techniques and school trips encourage an appreciation of art and the ability to be observant and discerning.

INSPIRING CURRICULUM

Languages

At St Ives we believe that in an increasingly competitive and global world the knowledge of foreign languages is essential. Learning a **modern foreign language** also enriches the curriculum in many ways; as well as creating an awareness of a different culture, the skills, knowledge and understanding gained by studying another language make a significant contribution to the development of children's oracy, literacy and to the understanding of their own culture.

Every child from Nursery through to Year 6 will experience language learning at St Ives. The main language taught is **French** and **Spanish** is studied as a secondary language.

Computing

St lves equips its pupils with the foundations of computing that they will need for the rest of their lives. Through the computer science element children grow in their understanding of computation and digital systems and apply this practically through writing, designing and debugging programmes. Children are given opportunities to use a range of information technology to develop ideas and create content. They become increasingly literate digital citizens, equipped to embrace the digital world safely and confidently. Computing enhances a range of cross curricular skills such as logical thinking, creativity, design, resourcefulness, ingenuity and problem solving. In all subject areas, technological resources, including iPads, interactive whiteboards and digital devices such as cameras and camcorders are used to benefit teaching and learning. The school has a purpose built computer suite.

Learning for Life

Learning for life is a new venture within the school curriculum. It embraces the **wider perspective** of learning, extending above and beyond the traditional curriculum. Its purpose is to help children develop a broader range of skills and knowledge to become **independent**, **creative** and **reflective thinkers**. It is another avenue for the children to gain confidence socially and personally, helping them to make the most of their futures now, at senior school and beyond.

Learning for life is a progressive three year programme which starts in Year 4 gaining momentum as the children journey through the school.

FOREST SCHOOL

Set within eight acres of **idyllic woodland**, learning at St Ives is not just limited to the classroom. Our outdoor areas provide a great resource for broader educational activities. Outdoor learning brings subjects such as Science, Geography, History and Art to life and plays a key role in the day to day teaching at St Ives.

Forest School is an **exciting** initiative which allows children to **explore** and experience the natural world around them, which gives them a wonderful opportunity to learn new **skills** such as wood carving, cooking and shelter building. Forest School is somewhere **everyone succeeds** and where no-one fails, it is a great way of helping develop social and **communication skills** along with confidence and self-esteem. Curriculum subjects are brought to life through Forest School, which is available to all children and is included in the timetable from Nursery through to Year 3.

Vouchers and Government Schemes


We accept both early years vouchers and employer childcare vouchers, and are part of the Early Years Funding Scheme.
